Introduction to Local Government Finance

Purpose

This introductory course will provide delegates with an understanding of local government finance. Delegates will gain background knowledge to wider context of public finance in which local government sits. They will gain an understanding of local government structures, and governance along with learning about different sources of local government funding and the complications and considerations that go alongside them. Delegates will also receive an introduction to important financial concepts such as capital and revenue, budgeting and financial reporting. This interactive course will involve quizzes, discussion points and plenty of opportunities to ask questions about local government finance.

Learning Outcomes

Attendees will benefit from:

- Gaining an understanding of the unique context in which local government operates including regulatory frameworks important for those working in the sector
- Understanding how local government is funded, including the restrictions that it must operate within and opportunities available to local government
- Understanding the difference between capital and revenue and how they are each financed
- An awareness of the various structures within local authorities and the governance arrangements for reporting and decision making
- An introduction to important financial concepts such as budgeting and financial reporting
- The opportunity to look at the risks and opportunities faced by local government and discuss the future of local government finance with colleagues

Who Will Benefit

This course is perfect for anyone new to local government and wants to get a better understanding of local government finance, how it is funded and understand financial concepts unique to local government.

It will also be useful for people new to managing budgets or finance roles, or those who want a refresher.
